Nacelle of evacuation for injured :
 In case of injury onboard a ship, according to the situation, you can solicit :
 - Damen : 02 98 43 43 43
 - AMB : 02 98 80 46 76 (multimodal platform : spreadable nacelle)

Instructions in case of accident / incident / suspicious behavior

- Protect and secure :**
- Urgency measures are intended to master the situation or take preventive measures in case an accident has already occurred
- Alarm :**
- Security/environment : call the harbor Master or the PC Security or the Police
 - Safety : Fire brigades (18 or 112) and employer
- Intervene :**
- **Notify the guardroom and go there to meet the rescue team**
 - Intervene according to your skills and means, without putting himself in danger
 - Accident : perform first aid actions
 - Dumping of hazardous products : use absorbents

- In the event of accident, information to be passed onto rescue team :**
- ✓ Give accurate location of the accident and meeting point for rescue team,
 - ✓ Nature of the accident and remaining risks,
 - ✓ Number of people involved,
 - ✓ Victims' apparent conditions,
 - ✓ First aid performed.
- Never cut off the line before you are told.**

You are entering in port industrial area !

Take contact with your port representative on site, it belongs to him to give you all the guidelines and safety/security instructions necessary for your intervention.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS



Speed limited to 30km/h except if more restrictive speed limit is requested



No parking on gantry rails, near gangways and railway tracks



Moving, driving and parking under loads is strictly prohibited (pedestrians, vehicles)



Smoking is prohibited in risk areas (dry bulk foodstuffs, hydrocarbons, ...)



Consumption of alcohol and drugs is prohibited

MANDATORY INDIVIDUAL PROTECTION



Safety shoes



Safety clothing



Helmet

Other PPE can be imposed on the quays and onboard ships by your port representative (reflecting clothing, life jacket, glasses, anti-noise headphones...).

SPECIFIC RISKS OF THE ACTIVITIES



Falling on ground slope / in the water



Crushing (gangway movement)



Falling load (cranes)



Collision with vehicles (king size, ...)



Explosion (Silos, gas station ...)



Fire (flammable products)

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

The proximity of the Brest roadstead adds to the need of a strict vigilance with regard to the various forms of pollution. You have to :

- Collect your waste and follow sorting instructions.
- Spare water and energy.
- Keep the docks in clean conditions



You are entering in a secured area !

ISPS area, International Ship & Port Security Facilities, meets the obligations fixed by the Maritime International Code. Port activities and ship repairs may be dangerous. Also, you must respect the following safety instructions :

SECURITY INTERDICTIONS



Authorised access only



No access without permission



No weapons



No incendiary devices and explosives

SECURITY INSTRUCTIONS



Security badges must be worn at all times
All persons must swipe in and out



Valid circulation pass or visible company logo mandatory
(Container Terminal and Shipyard)



Do not park in front of entrances/exits, use the drop-off areas



CCTV, access control and intrusion detection system 24/7



Security check and security controls 24/7
